

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of the participation of District residents in Board and/or School District committees. Therefore, with respect to any advisory, ad-hoc, general, special, and/or standing committees (except for committees comprised exclusively of Board members, and those committees whose membership and/or qualifications for membership are governed by applicable law and/or regulation, such as the Audit Committee, Shared Decision-Making Committee, Health and Safety Committee, etc.), any resident of the Center Moriches Union Free School District may join such committee as a member by submitting a completed application for same to the District Clerk, on a first-come, first-serve basis. Such applications shall be available through the Office of the District Clerk. Unless the membership of such committee is full (wherein the membership was previously established by the Board), any District resident who submits such completed application shall be permitted to join the requested committee(s).
